Shoot Fest – The Range

Open to all men and boys wanting to be certified to shoot black powder firearms, the NMLRA basic black powder course will be taught on Saturday, April 24, 2010 at the Range – starting at 9:00 am. A black powder shooter's card is required to shoot black powder rifles at any FCF or Royal Rangers event. The cost of the course is \$20 – please RSVP by April 19. Courses will also be offered to allow a participant to complete the Smallbore Shooting merit and the Shotgun Shooting merit (the Firearm Safety merit will be taught onsite just prior to starting the Smallbore and Shotgun Shooting merits). The cost of the Smallbore Shooting merit course is \$15 and the cost of the Shotgun Shooting merit course is \$25 – the location for all courses will be the Range starting at 9:00 am. The shooting requirement for the Smallbore Shooting merit is at least 100 shots of a .22 rimfire rifle and the shooting requirement for the Shotgun Shooting merit is at least 50 rounds from a .12 gauge shotgun – all materials, firearms and ammunition will be provided. Lunch will be provided for all participants in all three courses.

2010 Chapter Championships – May 8, 2010 – The Range

All chapter members will be tested in a variety of frontier skills. We will determine the most skilled competitor in each of four difficult trail walks – Hawk, Knife, Archery, and Muzzleloader. The top point earner in each skill event will be named a Chapter Skills Champion and will be awarded a special vest patch rocker (see back). A skill champion rocker patch can only be awarded if the 2010 event score exceeds the score recorded in 2009. Top-scoring individual for all events will earn a chapter vest patch. The top overall winners for 2009 were Kenny 'Pilgrim' Dunn for the Oldtimers and Jere 'No Stories' Romero for the Youngbucks.

2010 Frontier Adventure – June 18, 19 – The Range

The Frontier Adventure is a series of events which are used to determine if a greenhorn is qualified for FCF membership. A greenhorn will have an opportunity to engage in a number of required frontier skills - flint & steel fire starting, trap setting, hawk throwing, and knife throwing. The greenhorn will also gain knowledge about frontier cooking and shelters, common outfits present on the frontier, and highlights in the life of Jedediah Smith. The Frontier Adventure is the event the chapter uses to add individuals to the chapter membership – please submit applications for FCF membership by June 11, 2010.

Buckskin Adventure / Wilderness Vigil – Fall Trace – Oct 1,2 – The Range

All Frontiersmen that have met the requirements for advancement will have the opportunity to complete the Buckskin Adventure. The Buckskin Adventure will be an event trail with a series of skills testing including Flint & Steel, Black Powder or Primitive Bow, Tomahawk, Knife, Outfit, etc. Please fill out an advancement application and send it to Oak or Sap. All Buckskinners that have met the requirements for advancement to Wilderness will have the opportunity to complete the Wilderness Vigil. If you plan on advancing to Wilderness, please fill out an advancement application (website) as soon as possible because of the three month preparation period that is required prior to the vigil. Event will be scheduled depending on submitted applications.
