The Gold Cluster Award is a special achievement award for sectional commanders who have demonstrated outstanding service in achieving the goals of the overall Royal Rangers program. Except for the Leadership Training Course, National Training Camps, and other national training events, all points must be earned for service rendered during the current calendar year. The following is a list of categories in which points may be earned for this award:

Categories	Points
1. Chartered outposts:	
a. New charters: 3 points	
b. Renewal charters: 2 points	
2. Annual Activities:	
a. Royal Rangers Rally or Father/Son Banquet: 3 points each	
b. Other area activities: 2 points each	
3. Leadership training: 5 points for each section taught	
4. Sectional round tables: 3 points for each quarterly meeting conducted	
5. Local church presentations: 1 point for each meeting	
6. Royal Rangers displays: 3 points for each area display	
7. Promotional material: 2 point for each item published	
8. Personal contacts: 8 points for personal contacts with all churches in your area of responsibility on behalf of Royal Rangers at least twice a year	
9. Travel: 1 point for every 500 miles traveled on behalf of Royal Rangers	
10. Wearing of proper uniform during all Royal Ranger functions: 5 points	
11. Completion of Leadership Training Course I through V: 20 points	
12. Additional training (NTC, NTT, ANTC, etc): 5 points each per year	
13. Attendance at district functions (Pow Wow, FCF outings, other district events): 3 points each (Please list all events on a separate sheet)	
14. Attendance at territorial and national events: 3 points each	
15. Ranger of the Year program: 5 points	
16. Active FCF member: 2 points	
17. Current Red Cross card: 2 points for each card	
18. Sectional service project: 2 points for each project	
19. Active outpost leader: 5 points	
20. Completion of instructors certification seminar: 3 points

Requirements for Award

1. Cooperate with all district-related activities.
2. Complete the Leadership Training Course.
3. Earn 150 points.

All sectional commanders who meet the above qualifications will be eligible to receive and wear Gold Cluster Award from January 1 through December 31 of the current year in which the award is won. The evaluation sheet must be submitted to your District Commander by January 30. Complete and mail a copy of this form to the District Commander.
