Report & Scoring Information

* **Completed Chapter Scout Competition:** a chapter can gain points for a completed scout competition if a scout competition is completed during the reporting year or the year previous to the current reporting year.

** **Held a Chapter Wide Event:** a chapter wide event is defined as an event where the attendance for the event is open to all members of the chapter. Examples of chapter wide event would be Spring Trace, Fall Trace, Frontier Adventure, District Pow-wow, etc..

*** **Held a Competitive Event:** a competitive event is defined as an individual skill event conducted at an FCF event. Examples of a competitive event would be a hawk throw, a knife throw, a Seneca Run, a black powder shoot, etc..
