The Rangers Ministry Academy consists of six tracks

THE CHURCH LEADER

Ranger Orientation - Benefits/Value of Rangers training for pastors and those in church leadership.

THE SUPPORT STAFF

Outpost Committee Training - Online training for current or potential Outpost Committee members and other support staff.

Junior Leadership Foundations

Training for Discovery, Adventure and Expedition Rangers ready to serve in a new group leadership position.

Local Leadership Merits

Two taught each year in a five-week-meeting format or in a retreat setting. Designed to develop leadership skills for Discover, Adventure, and Expedition Rangers.

District Junior Leadership Development Camps

District level training that reinforces the lessons offered in the local leadership merits. Districts have great flexibility with a common philosophy and minimum core curriculum.

Action Camps

Hands-on, high action camps for high school students and adult leadership. Training intended to prepare local leadership to deliver meaningful and fun local activities.

THE ORGANIZATIONAL LEADER

The Organizational Leadership Training (OLT) track will challenge leaders to serve in positions beyond the local church, to grow spiritually, to develop well-rounded ministry competencies, and to enhance their leadership aptitudes. THE TRAINER



Training Academy

Training in teaching methods for potential certified instructors and those seeking recertification.



National Academy

Training in the disciplines required to serve as a staff member at leadership development events.



Advanced Academy

Training in the art of leading staff at leadership development events.



Academy Instructor

A member of the instructing staff at a National Academy or Advanced Academy.

Continuous Learning

Both national and district online and classroom training is offered.



Medal of Excellence

Represents a level of commitment and dedication to both the leaders' personal growth as well as the spiritual and leadership development of boys and young men.

Earned by completing the four levels of Outpost Leaders Advancement and by taking at least one boy on a journey culminating in the earning of the highest medal in any of the four Ranger groups.
